March 26-28, 2010

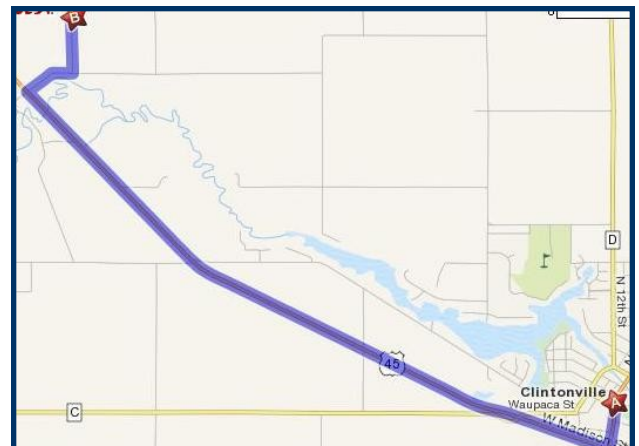
Arrival time: Noon on Friday
