

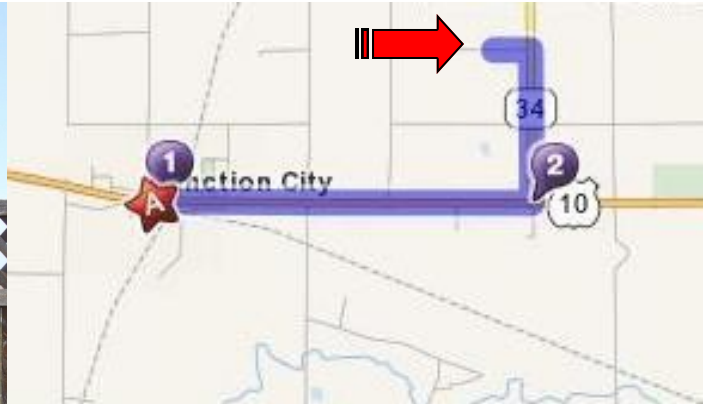


USSA's Wisconsin Turkey Hunt
